1. Easter Egg Hunt- Because of the construction taking place at our rec area on Rocky Hollow Rd, it was decided to change the venue of the Easter Egg Hunt. It will be held at the Wheeler Elementary school playground area. Starting time for the hunt will be 10 o'clock A.M. Special egg prizes, juice, coffee and Doughnuts will be served.
