BOOMBRIDGE ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT
OVER THE PAWCATUCK RIVER

BOOM BRIDGE ROAD, NORTH STONINGTON, CONNECTICUT
AND
BOOMBRIDGE ROAD, WESTERLY, RHODE ISLAND

*The North Stonington Board of Selectmen announced that the Town of North Stonington will hold a **Public Informational Meeting** on the replacement of the Boombridge Road Bridge over the Pawcatuck River. The bridge replacement project will receive federal funds under the Federal Bridge Program administered by the Connecticut Department of Transportation.*

The preliminary project design is complete, with construction likely to begin in the Spring of 2015.

The Selectmen point out that federal, state and local policies encourages early information to citizens on such projects; further people are encouraged to raise any concerns with municipal officials early in the planning process. The cost of the bridge replacement is slated for reimbursement from federal aid and the remainder from municipal funds.

The federal aid for the project is being authorized under the Federal Highway Administration, the Connecticut Department of Transportation and Town of North Stonington.
