- i. The purchase of 123a (Church) has not gone through to date due to communication issues between the attorneys. The closing should happen in the next few weeks.
- ii. The school house property was discussed with the North
 Stonington Historical Society. There could be a possibility of the
 historical society leasing the building from the town. Another
 update will be given at the next meeting.

i. The demolition is complete, grading has been completed on the property. The town is waiting for the final report from Eagle Environmental. First Selectman Urgo would like to have a sign in the location to mark where the house had been and the significance of the site.
