  - Selectman Carlson did research on ethics policies in other towns including Griswold, Stonington and Preston. He reported on his findings and discussion followed.
- 4. Coronavirus Relief Fund authorization
  - a. Update provided by Christine Dias, Administration & Finance Officer, regarding the FY2020 quarter 4 expenditures for COVID-19 for reimbursement through FEMA and the Coronavirus Relief Fund.
  - Motion by Selectman Carlson to authorize quarter 4 expenses for COVID-19 expenses totaling \$31,429.81 and seek reimbursement through FEMA and CRF, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Selectman Kincaid, motion approved 3-0-0

  - a. Strategic initiatives committee discussion: First Selectman Urgo discussed the strategic plan and the main items that need to be focused on by the town, infrastructure and housing. He introduced the idea of creating a task force to make sure the town is working toward a common goal on those items. Discussion followed.
