#### 1) Plans for pavilion structure

## 2) Green Gables Remediation – Internal and External Abatement

Contractor to arrive this week to perform the abatement on Green Gables. The soil was tested, there were some concerns with the soil. The town has to schedule the demolition of the Green Gables building within 30 days of the abatement being completed. The plan is for the town to pull down the Green Gables building the day after the abatement is complete.
