SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

The special meeting of the Hewitt Farm Committee was called to order by Chairman Ed Harasimowitz at 4:37 p.m. in the New Town Hall Conference Room with members Brian Banker, Ellie Banker, Jack Brown, Nita Kincaid, Tim Chokas and Ed Harasimowitz.
