



At the regularly scheduled December meeting of the North Stonington Conservation Commission, the commissioners voted unanimously to recommend the Town accept the Graminex and Marathon L.L.C. interest in donating approximately 100.02 acres of land off Wintechog Hill Road with an additional 8.02 acres to be accepted upon receipt of a clear title.

The Conservation Commission supports the intent of the Graminex and Marathon Investments, L.L.C. in their November 15, 2011 letter, to donate the properties for development of low cost and affordable housing adding that open space trails be incorporated in such planning and made available for public use.
