Any additional work performed will be in writing and approved by customer before work is done.

The Contractor shall hold all appropriate Connecticut installation licenses required. The Contractor is responsible for the delivery, uncrating, assembly, erection, piping, and wiring as stated above. The Contractor is responsible for the installation, testing and training of Highway Department staff and a qualified expert will start and test the system and explain complete operation. All Work shall be done in compliance with the Connecticut State Building and Fire Safety Codes.

Full payment will be made on satisfactory completion of the job and inspection certification by the Town's Building Official.

All equipment shall bear the manufacturer's warranty from the date of installation. All labor furnished by the Contractor will bear a one year warranty from the date of completion of the project against a defect in workmanship.

Also, it is understood by both parties that there are no verbal agreements whatsoever concerning this proposal and change orders will be made in writing.

Substitutions may be considered but must meet or exceed materials listed in quality and warranty and be compatible to existing components and existing system. Site Inspection is available upon request 7AM-3PM, Monday-Friday.
