Old Business:

- 3. Recreation Field Spring Work: NSLL has previously stated they will be doing some clean-up to the softball field area. Dir. Fabian noted field clean-up/re-seeding is to occur. Dir. Fabian is in contact with Wayne Coats and Jamie Bruce.
- 4. Sponsorship of 7/8 Grade boys team to Ledyard/Killingly Recreation Basketball Tournament: motion to sponsor this event for \$400 approved for the 7/8 grade boys in the tournament.
- 5. Youth Basketball Program Summary: The winter basketball program was reviewed both boys and girls had a travel team: 1 Sr. Boy travel team, 2 Jr. Boy travel teams, 1 Jr. Girl travel team.
