Ideas generated included: survey the public to get information on current housing needs and suggestions on how to help move the projects forward; explore deed restrictions for accessory units; permitting tiny houses, trailer parks and multi-family homes; consider primary goal of getting enough units to qualify for a 4-year moratorium; host Lunch and Learn for realtors with USDA & CHFA loan brokers; and create a map identifying all vacant land that could be used for housing.
- A. Kennedy had some questions for the committee to consider. What will be our process going forward? What goals and actions will we take?
- W. Mason called for a special meeting on Wednesday, April 14 at 5:30 p.m. Motion made and seconded (M. Leonard / P. Colgan) to hold a Special Meeting on 4/14/21. He tasked the committee to review the information about the Housing Plan and be prepared to share ideas. Motion passed.
