Expenditure of \$8,500 for conceptual plan for Wintechog Hill was approved by P&Z; McBroom will do this building on the feasibility study. Then matter will go to a town meeting, then to RFP.

Mobil display – been in Chelsea Bank; to go up at Wheeler Library in June; picture of the display was in the town's Quarterly Newsletter.

Everybody Needs a Home Bus Tour is going to Ferry Crossing in Old Saybrook and Watson Estates in town and possibly Spruce Meadows in Pawcatuck.
