- 2. **Public Comments- Nita Kincaid** In order to get North Stonington Quarterly out on time in January, Dan will receive an email tomorrow and should respond by the deadline in a week. **Dan Spring** suggested using the reports in the quarterly report to compile and use in the Town Report. **Shawn Murphy** commented about the budget. Dan Spring responded There was discussion.
- 3. Correspondence- Invoice from Sandra Welwood auditing services from last year not quite a 50 / 50 split Shawn asked if the numbers match the budgeted items Total \$6850.00 contracted for \$28k total for last year. Split between town and board of Ed \$3700.00 town \$3150 for Board of Ed. Tax Report -Demonstrates 100% collections uncollected taxes of \$150,808 Board of Finance had agreed to build budget at a 98% vs. 97% in prior year- Last year grand list was 522,068,114 -2017 Grand List reported by Daryl Delgrosso \$527,332,506. There was small growth in the grand list of about 1%. The Town has effectively managed debt and built fiscal strength of town from where we were in 2010. There was discussion. Dan look at this as a strategic plan maintaining public safety, education and economic development. People look for good outcomes direct correlation between education and economic development. Can do all while maintaining our agricultural land. Mustapha need to reach out to farmers and find out what we can do to develop their farms Dan need to develop better relationship with department of agriculture in the state- no reason why active farms in town can't come together and leverage No reason why farmers can't make a "cheese maker" Greenhouse- aqua culture very active many sites in No Sto could capitalize on this Used Terra Firma as example of using education and high quality food.
