1. Community Solar presentation

- a. Paul Michaud, Michaud Law Group, presented the RFP results for the community solar project at Wintechog Hill. Michaud and Tory Hanna, Davis Hill Development, answered questions regarding the community solar project at Wintechog Hill.

2. 119 Clarks Falls Road update

- a. First Selectman Urgo provided an update on the property and the RFP that was posted for the relocation of the school house. No bids were received. Discussion of what to do with the school house followed. The town will put together an RFP for the use and maintenance of the school house building. A draft will be discussed at a future meeting.
