- 2. Update of rototilling/seeding at Pocket park Mike deferred
- 3. 2019 Calendar Printed 125; 108 sold, 10 gifted \$1080 returned to general fund

  - b. Planning for 2021: Events? Commissioners to get ideas to Bill (still waiting).
