## Old Business:

- Calendar sales Bill
  - \$670 returned to the town. 2 commissioners need to return \$60 (Jason) and \$30 (Mike) to close this out.
- Progress on Boombridge Road river trail access Bill
  - Keith Grove representing the Mashantucket Tribe met with Mike Urgo and Bill Ricker at the Boombridge Road bridge. 40 Yards further downstream from the original proposed kayak put in/take out area, another potential put in/take out was noted. Keith will provide a map of the area in a couple of weeks. If approved by the Tribe, this would be a great solution. The Town would need to approve a release of liability to use this area.
- Our 2022 calendar theme: "Farmers and Their Animals."
  - We have 17 farms that will be contacted in the near future.
- Trail maps: reprinted maps now are faded. Future duplicates will be made from the original.
- Update: Fire Fly Farm LLC modification of Atty Gen decision
  - o Van Brown is now back in town. Principals agreed to discuss and notify us. Ultimately, this needs to be approved by the CT Attorney General via a "friendly law suit".
- Historic Trail progress Steve
  - An advanced draft of the North Stonington Historic Walking Trail Map was reviewed. Several modifications were suggested.
  - Before the map is finalized, we will show what is proposed to the town attorney, Amy Kennedy and perhaps others.
