## Emergency Services Operations Committee Special Meeting Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.

## **Meeting Minutes**

- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:15. Attendees included Charlie Steinhart, Jim Tuttle, Sarah Nelson, Tricia Cunningham, Carl Johnson.
- 2. Approval of meeting minutes tabled.
- 3. Guest Presenter, Battalion Chief Brandon Raquet from Worcester, PA Fire Department joined to provide an overview on recruitment and staffing strategy. The overview included:
  - Manage 233-250 calls per year, primarily residential and farmland with minimal commercial
  - Created a committee a committee for recruitment and retention and executed the following initiatives
    - Stipend for volunteers payout at the end of the year
    - Enabled local municipalities to over tax credit for local town taxes
    - Township employee incentive to address daytime volunteer shortage
      - 7 full time and one part time employee are volunteer fire fighters
      - They are provided a 6K full time and 3k part time stipend from the town to participate as volunteers
      - Volunteers respond to daytime calls and are allocated 3 hours per week to conduct training
    - Refined recruitment and training process
      - Assigned two advocates to all new recruits focused on mentorship
      - Offered inhouse tract that allows folks to volunteer in different ways
      - Upgraded fire department to create an engaging atmosphere and fun place to be
        - Renovated members room
        - Upgraded gym to keep volunteers on site



## North Stonington, Connecticut

- Recruitment strategies included social media tools to target specific demographics and locations, sign out front, recruitment rewards, public events and members
- New recruits are given a skills package
- Recruits run initiatives, for example running drills, enables training & retention
- Focus on catering interests to skills
- 4. Survey Data Review Reviewed fire department funding models including fire tax/fire district.
- 5. Next Steps
  - Potential recommendations to Selectmen Board
    - Offer stipend to town employees to become part of NSVFD
    - Continue volunteer recruitment
    - Need for some level of paid staffing
