5. OLD BUSINESS:

#18-003 Application of Jason Horowitz (GBT Realty, Inc.) North Stonington DCTP, LLC, 9010 Overlook Boulevard, Brentwood, TN 37027 for property owned by Barbara Rubenstein Trust et al, for a for the construction of a 9,224 sq. ft. 1-story retail building with associated parking,

landscaping improvements, storm water detention/treatment system, private well, private on-site sewer disposal system & other utility infrastructure on property located at Clarks Falls Road in an HC Zone. Tax Map #112, Lot #4527

Mr. James Bernardino, Bohler Engineering was present for this application.

Mr. Bernardino gave a brief review of the site-plan which was continued from the Commission's January 10th meeting.

The Commission discussed and had no issues with the proposal.

Salvatore and Sergio Cherenzia were also present to discuss a possible lot line adjustment involving this parcel which would require a wetlands crossing. The Commission stated they were open to this, but a formal application would need to be submitted.

MOTION by R. Lewis, SECOND by C. Palmer to approve application #18-003 with the following conditions:

- 1. The Wetlands Office to be contacted prior to construction to allow the Wetlands Enforcement Officer to inspect:
 - a. before construction starts, and
 - b. that the Erosion & Sediment Controls are installed per plan.

7. DISCUSSION:

Proposed Ordinance regarding reducing the 9 member board to Regular Members/Alternates to ensure a quorum for monthly meetings.

The Commission discussed and the consensus was to change the 9 member board to a 7 member board as it always seems they are waiting on the 5th member to have a quorum of 5. A 7 member board would mean the Commission would need 4 members to have a quorum.
