  - c. Time line of Elem progress as MHS had timeline that website was disconnected due to cost.
  - d. Meeting minutes are not online this will be verified and they will be updated to reflect current and past meetings
  - e. Teachers would like up to date map of Elem and weekly updates updates will start shortly per CM and no dimensions of rooms have changed from original map drawing per Architect.
  - f. Punch list of items to be fixed at MHS and when they will be complete CM/Architect have been looking and already fixing certain items such as backing up sewage and looking at ways to area safer with more signage.
  - g. Village concerns with look and feel if demo is completed have been looking at other uses for school and keeping education first.
  - h. State Reimbursement for project long process along with new State system; submit.. approval.. reimbursement. July submission was just paid out approx. two weeks ago.
  - i. Town is not fully aware of demo and what that actually means remains on Add/Alternative list and will till end of project when can re-evaluate.
