  - Mention the WPCA's guidance for maintaining and operating a residential/commercial septic appeared in The North Stonington Quarterly Summer 2023 edition. I am named the contact in the post. There have been no inquiries to date.
  - > Damion Barrett landowner in the RC Zone has been inquiring of the status of amending the WPCA regulations to establish a second sewer district, regardless of if there is a commitment from the MPTN. Will meet with Mr. Barrett on 7/20/2023 to discuss the potential of using a sewage treatment package plant instead of a sewer line.
  - Discuss a process for the WPCA to provide technical assistance and oversight to the selectmen's office regarding planning and developing public well water systems and

related issues. Also, the need to amend the ordinance and regulations establishing the WPCA to include water systems.

#### 6. New Business:

- > Update on the discussion of a prospective mixed-use development located at 139 Norwich Westerly Road. The meeting was done via Zoom with Bob Carlson, Ariel Lago, town planner, and me. Talked about the prospect of extending public sewer and water from Stonington/Westerly, RI. The developer is providing potential flow volumes, which I will compare to the amount last allocated to the Town by Stonington more than 10 years ago. I will keep you posted.
- > Hand out and discuss the surface water quality monitoring data for the 2022 sampling results and write up.
- > Provide an overview regarding the septic system pump out ordinance and my discussions with the health department, Cheryl Haase. Decide whether the Authority would like Cheryl to attend the next meeting to provide an overview of the health department's role. She's willing to attend.
- > Go over Sewer Service Area Map
