 - Discuss WPCA's potential role and coordination in assisting the Board of Selectmen with the planning and development of new public/community water systems in Town.
 - > Damion Barrett, landowner, requested that the town send a letter (distributed at meeting) to the MPTN to resume discussions to extend utilities off its reservation to the RC Zone. Also asked to move forward with amending the WPCA regulations to establish a second sewer district. I met with Mr. Barrett to discuss the potential of

- using a sewage treatment package plant instead of a sewer line. Set up meeting with DEEP since it is permitting authority.
- > Status on the WPCA plan update-Juliet Hodge has reviewed the document and provided some constructive comments. Making changes and preparing maps. She will have the consultant for the POCD help me with making maps.
- > Solicit comments from members of the WPCA member regarding surface water sampling report. It will be included in the Plan update.

6. New Business:

- ➤ Provide update on the inquiry about public utilities at 45 Frontage Road. Loureiro Engineering is doing a feasibility study. It is a +/- 55-acre site owned by MPTN and has an existing garage on it.
- > Inquiry regarding development located at 139 Norwich Westerly Road not likely going anywhere.
- > Provide an overview regarding the septic system pump out ordinance and my discussions with the health department, Cheryl Haase. Decide whether the Authority would like Cheryl to attend the next meeting to provide an overview of the health department's role. She's willing to attend.
