Selectmen Update/Comments

- Speed hump on Billings Lake Rd. was reinstalled with double sided tape.
- The town talked about moving rocks around the parking area to stop illegal parking.
- The walking path has been reopened at Billings Lake, which created one more parking spot for hikers.
- Resident on Button Rd. wants speed limit changed from 35 to 25.
- Resident wants deer crossing signs put up on Wyassup Rd. in the area of the fairgrounds.
- Speed humps to be installed in the Village. Will start with half of the amount. Orange stakes are installed to show where they're being installed.

Billings Lake Update/Reports

- The town is unable to install any more speed humps on Billings Lake Rd. due to factors such as drainage, corners and curves in the road.
- Speed monitoring unit will not be placed on Billings Lake Rd.
