No Public Comments

Selectmen Update/Comments

- A lot more rocks have been installed up at Billings Lake to keep cars to a minimum.
- Speed humps are all back in on Billings Lake Rd.
- Board of Selectmen approved four speed humps to be installed in the Village. Two by the library and two by the Baptist church. Board of Selectmen will meet again in the Spring to see if the speed humps have worked.
- One of the electronic speed limit signs from the Village will be moved to Rocky Hollow Rd.

Billings Lake Update/Reports

- Britt Tella stated that there are 6 to 8 spots to park at the boat launch for boats and trailers. Boaters can't park there because cars are parked there.
- Bob Carlson will check with DEEP to see if they've been up there.
- Britt Tella stated that cars are speeding in between the speed humps. Trooper McCarthy stated that he has conducted speed enforcement and cars are traveling 23-25mph.
- Resident from Cedars Rd. stated that cars are not stopping at the stop signs that were installed last year at Cedars Rd. and Legend Wood Rd. because the signs don't have any markings on them that they are a town approved sign. The highway department will look into this.

Main St./Rocky Hollow Rd. One Way Suggestion

- Marilyn Mackay suggested that Main St. down from the Red Onion be one way into the Village and Rocky Hollow Rd. out of the Village be one way out to Rt. 2.
