To all RENTERS in the Town of North Stonington:

The State of Connecticut Renters program is set to begin again. As most of you know, the application period starts on April 1, 2020 and runs unto October 1, 2020. With the Corona-19 virus in the news, the most important thing that all residents do, is to stay safe. Please note that the timeline for applications shows that there is plenty of time to file. You will not receive your check any earlier by filing early.

Due to the Connecticut's Governors request for all of us to stay safe, you may drop off your application and paperwork at the drop off box outside the new town hall to file your application for the renter's assistance program. There will be no personal contact until the governor's office issues an all clear statement. Please call the Assessor's Office Monday thru Thursday 8:00 am to 4:00 pm at the number listed above or email the assessor's office at the following address ddelgrosso@northstoningtonct.gov. for additional information.

The Assessor's Office has instituted several ways to file your paperwork for the Connecticut Renters program. The signed and dated application, plus proof of income and utility statements may be dropped off outside the office at the new town hall in the new drop box, mailed to the assessor's office or emailed to us at ddelgrosso@northstoningtonct.gov. Please complete the application, sign and date it. It is not necessary to copy any document's since we will return all paperwork by mail.

New applicants for the program must be at least 65 years old on January 1, 2020 or be classified as having a 100% disability rating from Social Security. Maximum income for a married couple is \$45,100 and for a single individual the maximum income is \$37,000. In order to complete the application, we need proof of all income including your social security Form 1099 for 2019 plus your utility bills for 2019 which include your electric statements for the year, gas statements, heating oil statements & water bills. If you are missing some key paperwork, you may call the assessor's office and we may be able to help you obtain a replacement copy.

Included with this letter is an application that you must sign, date and include your phone number. The office will use the information provided to complete the form. Please return the signed and dated form with the supporting information before October 1, 2020.
