- 1. Discussion on properties to be included in Sewer District and estimated flows: Discussed the various vacant parcels in the EDD and I Zones and possible future developments. Members would like to host a meeting (facilitated by a consultant) with the landowners near Exit 92 in particular to discuss the sewer district proposed phases for development and the potential tie-in with Stonington. Also want to gauge any interest in tying into the Westerly water system (if feasible).
- 2. Possible Waterline extension to KOA: Discussed KOA's interest in tying in to Westerly Water. Unsure of the process. J. Hodge and M. Urgo and members of the WPCA will meet with Westerly Town Officials to discuss.
- 3. Water Testing: Water testing can begin after the start of the fiscal year. J. Hodge to meet with Cummins Envirotech to discuss initial testing.
