New Business:

1. Community Well Request: M. Urgo discussed the community well being requested for the Vineyard/Wedding Venue. As the Town is not equipped to accept the well and do all the required testing etc. the well will be owned by the vineyard. Given the number of new developments in the pipeline that will require their own community wells, the extension of water utilities or a plan to combine these small systems into one must be addressed soon. Absolutely needs to be part of the POCD process. Suggested a community dialog about the utility extension issue in general. J. Hodge discussed the need to update the inventory of new septic systems and community wells and to conduct water testing to identify trouble spots and/or verify that the original testing areas are still coming up clean.

Mike to reach out to Westerly Water to get an update on their continued interest and ability to supply water to select parcels.
