**Plan Update and Water Testing:** J. Hodge outlined some of the tasks the WPCA members needed to accomplish as part of the process of updating their 1994 Plan. She will assign each member with a document to review and summarize for the rest of the members at the next meeting.

**Community Well – 76 Norwich Westerly Rd:** M. Uργο discussed the request made for the Town to assume ownership of a new proposed Community well at the recently approved gas station at 76 Norwich Westerly Rd. After discussing the issue at a recent meeting with some WPCA members, staff, DPH and DEEP, he is recommending that the Town not assume ownership. The owners of the gas station would be obligated to tie-in to a water main should one ever be installed along Rte. 2. The well does not impact our ESA status at this time and the Town would have to hire someone to monitor the well etc.

**Water/Sewer Extension Updates:** No updates on the sewer extension. K. Labbe is still working with the private parties interested in investing in public water infrastructure. Tying in to Westerly still seems like the best option for now, but Westerly is limited in supply and will need to develop a new well if they are to provide water to more than the 3 properties originally envisioned.
